The Rochdale Canal is one of the area's greatest heritage assets. It was completed in 1804 and runs for 33 miles from Manchester to Sowerby Bridge through the boroughs of Oldham and Rochdale.

For many years it was used to transport goods weighing up to 2,000 tons a day (that's the weight of about 500 elephants!) But when the faster Leeds - Manchester railway was completed in 1852, the canal became less attractive for transporting goods across the Pennines.

Today the canal is used for a different purpose, one of leisure and recreation and is popular with boaters, anglers, walkers, cyclists, wildlife and nature enthusiasts and loads more...
